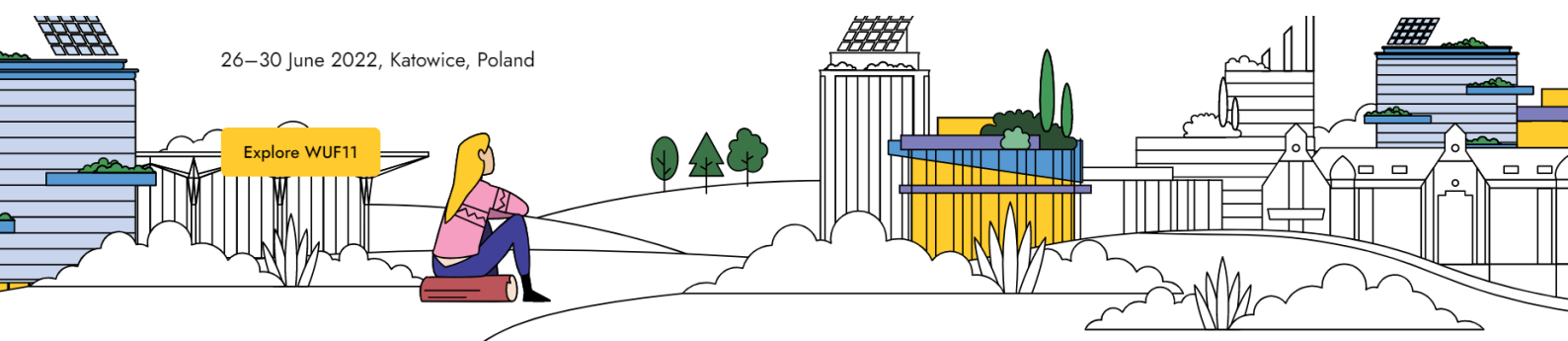
Concept Note

Spain has been one of the first countries worldwide to approve its National Urban Policy. It did so on February 22, 2019, under the name of the Spanish Urban Agenda. It is not only a short, medium and long-term Strategy, but also a true working method that has a flexible methodology, capable to attract all interested parties, and mainly local governments, to its effective implementation. The Spanish State has its own Action Plan, which is being implemented with regulatory, financing and governance measures. The National Administration also accompanies and advises more than one hundred local Entities of all sizes, characteristics and populations, so that they will provide, in less than a year, a local Action Plan developing the global sustainability objectives proposed by the Urban Agenda at the local level. The Event proposed for the WUF is aimed at sharing state, regional and local experiences in the field of action, that is, the effective implementation of a National Urban Policy among all levels of administration involved.

Objectives

- Know the National Urban Policy of Spain and the way in which its effective implementation is being carried out (with regulations, planning, financing, governance and dissemination of knowledge).
- Share good practices and proven experiences in the preparation and approval of urban agenda action plans at the national, regional and local levels.
